A Closer Look

This section features more in-depth analysis on selected events from each card of racing at Harrah's Philadelphia, with something for the novice player and seasoned handicapper alike.

1 **5 - PAN OF STEEL** won powerfully on debut for new connections last week, and he's hit the exacta in seven straight at this level. Tetrick stays with the versatile 11-time winner, who shows pacesetting, brushing, pouncing and stalking ability alike. **4 - WESTERN ROCKSTAR A** missed the start by a few lengths after an early break in a \$15k race last week, but he did well to chase the field and make late headway. A cleaner start on this drop back to a proven level makes him a big factor. **1 - LYON'S IMAGE** likewise drops from \$15k company after being softened up by pressure on the far turn. He won at that level five back from first-over and seven back from the point. Be mindful of value offered on this step down.

2 The top two mares in last week's distaff claiming pace and the top two from a fortnight ago all meet here, making for a compelling contest with lots of options and not much space between them. **8 - LIVE ODDS** sprinted off at will on Nov. 22 to earn a third straight win. She's scored from the pocket, in the breeze, and off cover in this recent stretch. Today she debuts for Hall, and Nap opts on. **7 - PART-TIME HANOVER** picks up Tetrick after her 3-1/4 length win at twos-on last week. The week before (the Live Odds race), she was mired in traffic up the far side but mustered mild gains once free. **5 - WYNNFRITH** proved she can sustain wide bids for minors pretty well in recent weeks, and at 8-1 in the book, she seems a strong value option for all exotics if availed clear cover.

4 **1 - BLACKWELL RUBY IR** won her American debut soundly, mounting a middle move and drawing off from similar at tens-on with plenty in reserve. Almost nothing changes today from last week — the second-, third- and fourth-place finishers all return as well. **6 - A ROCKNROLL BUS** chased for second up the open stretch after being pinned in last week, and she's hit the board in five of six. She's a consistent factor for at least a share regardless of the trip she receives. **5 - STICK THAT LIP OUT** was all-out to give chase last week — and beaten for second by 1-1/2 lengths — but her early exertion to clear from post 7 and the fact she had to chase a strong Blackwell Ruby IR both serve as legitimate excuses for late regression.

8 **4 - CLAREBEAR** struggled late last week after being shuffled out of contention, but had better showings with tougher yet two and three back. Further relief can lift her, and 5-1 is more than fair given her big-picture performance over the last few months. **6 - BELIEVE IN ME** jumps a level after a powerful front-end score in New Jersey, but previous lines were a mixed bag. McCarthy stays; mind value. **8 - KOTARE YARRA N** moves in from \$20k company at Yonkers and Dover, where she gave stout pursuit from tracking trips. Yonkers lines with tougher earlier in the fall encourage; expect a better performance than her 15-1 morning line might indicate.

10 **1 - FOREVERHILLREIGN** hit the board in all four of his starts since returning to action, but now graduates to the N5L ranks off an odds-on win last out. Miller opts on this one over Smokee Mirrors, with whom he just missed at this level on arrival from New Jersey last week. **3 - SMOKEE MIRRORS** nearly converted at 12-1 last week after a gritty bottom-level defeat in East Rutherford on Nov. 22. He can brush or lift off cover alike, it appears. **6 - FRESHETTE HANOVER** graduated from the N3L ranks by virtue of career earnings in her last, and has shown consistent pressing and stalking ability in recent starts in both the States and Ontario. Tetrick's choice.

12 **7 - JIVE DANCING A** nearly lasted at this level last week after a solid pillar-to-post odds-on score on Nov. 15. She's won three of her last four tries at this class, and Napolitano stays on over two others. Plenty to like, to be sure. Her main competition comes in the form of a rising **1 - GLORIOUS MATE**, who debuts for Crissman after success late in the Hoosier meet. She's rounded into pretty strong form, but the fact she's been off nearly a month presents a big unknown in terms of fitness. Mind value. **4 - LINCOLN'S GIRL N** chased well for minors in two starts since rising to this level. Good staying power off wide trips encourages; expect her to be involved for at least a share.
